**Sector best practice case studies available**

The Federation has today released its latest good practice resource for the community housing sector. This resource supports providers in playing a lead role in developing and implementing strategies for community engagement and community building. It can be downloaded [here](#).

It provides a context for considering best approaches to engaging local communities in community development activities, including in tenant economic engagement. It describes community engagement and participation options and examines community housing's role in community development.
