Training Prices February to June 2018

This pricing structure will be implemented for all new training services or contracts delivered from 1st January 2018 to the 30th June 2018. You will notice that these prices are unchanged from 2017

Please note that pricing may be negotiated if you are a non-member and wish to enrol a large group of students in a unit whether online or face to face. Please contact the Training Manager to discuss your options.

CHC42215 Certificate IV in Social Housing

- Students are required to complete 15 units of study from the Certificate IV program to receive the qualification. (8 core units and 7 elective units)
- The recommended timeframe for students to complete the qualification is between 12 to 18 months from the date of enrolment.
- Pricing applies to face to face and online training. Please discuss pricing for distance training and recognition of prior learning with the Training Manager.
- There are 2 extended units within the Certificate IV program that need to be delivered over a longer period of time and therefore attract a higher cost.
- The CTSH delivers clustered units that combine related units of study. This allows students to complete multiple units of study at the same time and streamlines the amount of time each student needs to invest into attending classes and completing their assessments. **The cost for cluster units is cheaper than if they were done individually.**

CHC52015 Diploma of Community Services

- Students are required to complete 16 units of study from the Diploma program to receive the qualification. (8 core units and 8 elective units)
- The recommended timeframe for students to complete the qualification is between 18 to 24 months from the date of enrolment.
- Pricing applies to face to face and online training. Please discuss pricing for distance training and recognition of prior learning with the Training Manager
- Some units in the Diploma of Community Services require a Work Placement – if you are currently working then this can be used as you placement.

Administration Fee

From the 1st January 2018 CTSH is introducing an administration fee to cover additional costs such as withdrawals, re-issuing Certificates and student support. This fee is \$75 per student per year and will be included in your first invoice. The fee also applies to students undertaking training through Smart and Skilled
